The [Browne Center](#) has developed a series of innovative [theme based programs](#). By providing an adventurous scenario, students are fully engaged as they develop socio-emotional skills in teamwork, group decision making, leadership, appropriate risk taking, and more!

Mount Everest (half-day) This simulated adventure begins at Base Camp where climbing teams must plan their expedition to the top of the world. While “roped up,” teams rely on the trust built between one another to work through difficult challenges they encounter as they ascend to the summit of Mt. Everest.

Shackleton's Voyage (half-day) Join sir Ernest Shackleton's Imperial Trans-Antarctic Expedition to make the first overland crossing of the Antarctic. Leadership, teamwork, and collective decision making are required in this simulated journey to reach the old Whaling Station on the island of South Georgia.

Iditarod (half-day) Beginning with images and stories from Anchorage, AK, teams work collaboratively to assemble their sleds. Racing across the frozen landscape, teams pull together as they encounter multiple challenges en route to the finish line.

March of the Penguins (half-day) Every year, the entire colony of Emperor penguins undertake arduous journeys between the ocean and the breeding grounds to feed their chicks. Community collaboration will be required as teams try to save as many chicks as possible.

Odyssey (full-day) Join Odysseus and his ships on an epic journey. Crew members will need to use their cunning intelligence to find creative solutions to the many varied challenges/obstacles they encounter on their way home to Ithaca.
